
Number and Types of Cases

Regular cases include subject matters dealing with carding, contracts or agreements, eligibility, governance, team selection and other disputes.

Dispute resolution services are offered to National Sport

Organizations or Canadian Multisport Services Organizations at no cost.

Any other member of the Canadian sport community can utilize these services on a fee per use basis.

Doping cases are related to violations of the Canadian Anti-Doping Program (CADP) as administered by the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport (CCES). The SDRCC is Canada's designated Doping Tribunal since 2004.
