


ORDINARY TRIBUNAL

Appeal Allowed/Denied: An Arbitrator rendered an award in favor/against the Claimant.

Consent/Settlement: Parties reached a mutually agreed upon solution without the need for an arbitration hearing.

Appeal Withdrawn: The Claimants rescinded their appeal voluntarily; in some cases because parties reached a settlement independently from the SDRCC process.

Jurisdiction Denied: When appeals are filed with the SDRCC without the prerequisite conditions being met, an arbitrator may declare that the SDRCC does not have jurisdiction to hear those cases.



DOPING CASES

Sanctions: The duration of an ineligibility period varies depending on the nature of the violation. It is determined by an Arbitrator following a hearing, depending on the circumstances of each case.

Waiver: When persons accused of doping violations waive their right to a hearing and accept the sanction proposed by the CCES.

No Violation: When the Arbitrator finds that the person was not in violation of the anti-doping rules.
