Dr. Ian Johnson, C. Med., BA., MA, MACR, LLM, PhD is the President of Kykaik Inc., Negotiation and ADR services. He is an Ontario based mediator, negotiation consultant, process facilitator and trainer.

Dr. Johnson is a member of the Ontario Attorney General's Roster for Mandatory Mediation and the CCAC roster of Independent Complaints Facilitators, in addition to the roster of mediators for the Sports Dispute Resolution Centre of Canada.
