Mastop</i></b> (lead prosecutor): the accused, a lawyer, was charged with participating in the activities of a criminal organization, the first such prosecution in Canada. The accused pleaded guilty in December 2012, and will be sentenced in early 2013.</li><li>• <b><i>R. v. Sipes et al.</i></b> the successful prosecution of five gang members charged with three separate murders in Vernon, B.C. in 2004 and 2005. From 2008 until 2012, I was one of four senior Crown counsel on a team of nine prosecutors. The case ended in November 2012 after an 18-month jury trial (the longest in Canadian legal history) with convictions of all accused on all murders.</li><li>• <b><i>R. v. Biller and Slobogian</i></b>: a commercial crime fraud of \$100 million, the largest commercial crime case in British Columbia. From 2000 to 2004 I headed a four-member prosecution team which successfully</li></ul>
