### **Closure of the Abuse-Free Sport Registry and OSIC Signatory Portal**

Brossard (Quebec) - The Sport Dispute Resolution Centre of Canada (SDRCC) informs National Sport Organizations and Multisport Organizations that the Abuse-Free Sport Registry will close on June 30, 2026.

In coordination with Sport Integrity Canada, this closure forms part of the continued transition from Abuse-Free Sport to the Canadian Safe Sport Program.

The closure applies to both components of the registry: the public Office of the Sport Integrity Commissioner (OSIC) Sanctions Registry and the private and secure OSIC Signatory Portal.

As of June 30, 2026, these tools will no longer be accessible. The [sportintegritycommissioner.ca](https://sportintegritycommissioner.ca) and [abuse-free-sport.ca](https://abuse-free-sport.ca) websites will also be taken offline at the same time.

Relevant public information from the Abuse-Free Sport Registry has been transferred to Sport Integrity Canada's Canadian Safe Sport Program Public Registry.

Abuse-Free Sport and OSIC content that remains useful for reference has been moved to the Safe Sport page on the SDRCC's current website:
