

Tier 1 - Education and Awareness Checklist

Note that all capitalized terms in this document refer to defined terms in the Implementation Guide.

Purpose

This checklist is intended to foster a culture of education and awareness surrounding *Maltreatment* and *Discrimination* in sport, aiming to create a safe and respectful environment for all *Participants*. Consider implementing and adopting these practices to improve education and awareness within your sport organization.

Safe Sport Education and/or Training

- ☐ All *Participants* in a position of trust or authority have completed approved safe sport *Education* and/or *Training* before employment or appointment begins, on an annual basis.
- ☐ Refresher courses are offered thereafter.
- ☐ Your sport organization has a current record of successful completions of safe sport *Education* and/or *Training* and keeps it up to date.
- ☐ Everyone in your sport organization is reminded and informed that they play a role in keeping sport safe for all *Participants*.
